

Types of mobility



Degree mobility

Full accredited degree programme in higher education in the destination country.



Credit point mobility

Obtaining credit points for a full degree programme back in the country of origin.



' (Institutional mobility)

Mobility of degree programmes or entire education institutions

(Virtual mobility)

Distance based learning, MOOC's, etc.

- Visa permissions <u>IND</u>
- Programme management <u>Erasmus+</u>
- Student surveys (ROA, Desan)
- UNESCO, OECD, EUROSTAT

Definitions: degree mobility

1st: International student:

Prior education (high school, ISCED 3) diploma from outside the country of Higher Education enrolment

- Includes 'homecoming students' (NL)
- Nationality no exclusive criterion



Nationality (citizenship) other than the country of Higher Education enrolment.

- Includes students who are actually non-mobile







Definition: credit mobility

Obtainment of credits (ECTS) with study-related activities in a country different from the country of Higher Education enrolment (ISCED 5, 6, 7 or 8)

- Enrolment in for degree obtainment
- Nationality is no criterion
